Calls to the Office: We are asking that you remember that Ms. McInnis has many duties added to her schedule with Covid practices. Please remember to put a note in your child's

communication folder/backpack if they are changes to their afterschool arrangements. Calling the school after lunch when it is always busy and relaying messages is very difficult and may cause bus disruptions for all.

Report Cards: Report cards will go home via email on November 30th. If you have recently changed your email please call and make sure we have the correct email address. Teachers will share at Parent/Teacher via Google Meet or phone call meetings on/week of November 25th what you can expect to see reflected in your child's report. After the reports come home, should you have any follow up questions, you can always contact your child's teacher.

Parent/Teacher Meetings: Thursday, November 25th is the official "parent/teacher" day for Humber Park. There is NO school for students that day as teachers have professional development in the morning. These meetings will be done via phone or Google Meet and teachers will be contacting parents during their scheduled time; there will be NO in-person meetings. More information on how to set up a meeting will come from your child's teacher, so please watch your e-mail. We wanted to give you as much notice as possible so you can try to plan around your work schedule.

Healthy Hunger Hot Lunch: Ordering is now open on-line for Subway on Tuesdays and Little Ceasar's Pizza on Fridays. School Cancellations: In the event of school cancellation, please call 464-INFO or check the front page of the Halifax Regional Center for Education website: <a href="www.hrce.ca">www.hrce.ca</a>. If you would like to receive text message notification of school closure, visit <a href="www.hrce.ca">www.hrce.ca</a> as well and look for the icon at the left of the web page and follow the steps!

Please be sure to keep the emergency dismissal information you provided us for your child up to date in the event of a school closure during the day. Please note that Humber Park belongs to the "Auburn" family of schools.

School Ground Safety: Families are reminded about being mindful of where you stop when dropping off children in the mornings. Please do not stop in the bus stop areas, park across the street from where the buses stop and/or drive your vehicles onto school grounds. There

are signs posted that indicate both these expectations but are not always being followed. We have had many vehicles who are stopping in front of the school who are blocking buses as they arrive. Please respect these designated areas.

Home & School: Thank you to all the families who supported our Cookie Dough sales. The Cookie Dough will be delivered to the school on November 25th and families can pick them up between 11 AM to 6PM. These MUST be picked on November 25th as due to Covid-19, they CANNOT be stored in the school and any cookie dough that has not been picked up will either be given away or thrown away. Please arrange for someone to pick the orders up for you if you cannot.
